## **LOCATION**



UNAJ is located in Florencio Varela, next to Berazategui, 25 km south from Buenos Aires.

Since the beginning of its first term in 2011, the number of students attending classes has risen to 23,049.








### SCHOOL OF HEALTH SCIENCES: RESEARCH PROGRAMS

Maternal and Child Health: this program addresses issues such as maternal and child policies, perinatal networks, innovations in this field, and contributions for policy-making from areas such as nutrition, early child development and neurosciences. The program seeks to promote the production of knowledge and interactions between professors, researchers and social actors linked to the field of study of Maternal and Child Health from an ethical perspective.

Socio-Cultural Dimensions and Communication of Health: standing at the intersection of Social Sciences and Health, this program combines approaches coming from disciplines like sociology, anthropology, social communication, and psychology. The program's goal is to promote research, transfer and training projects with an interdisciplinary approach and using socio-cultural and communicational tools for addressing sanitary issues

Policies and Management of Health Service Networks: this program seeks to contribute to diminishing the gaps between theory and practices in the sanitary area. It addresses issues such as health policies and systems, tools for managing network services, new technologies and management of health service networks, regional integration and compared health systems, networks and the right to health, and economy of health.

**Transmissible Diseases:** the program studies the epidemiology of the regional distribution of resistant bacterial strains and to develop a methodology for early detection; circulation, characteristics of strains and load of disease of viral and bacterial pathogens of interest to our population; developing methodologies for





detecting agents of interest according to the needs of the local population and the indigenous strains; explore new immunogens with potential for developing vaccines.

Community Health: the program's goal is to generate and share knowledge related to conditions of health, disease, attention, and care for the population living in the region where the university is located. It studies the health situation from the perspective of social determinants of health, in order to achieve a better understanding of socio-sanitary phenomena and to contribute to policy-making.

Research Program on Noncommunicable Diseases: This program aims to address the complex causes of noncommunicable diseases (NCDs) and the reduction of global burden, using an interdisciplinary perspective and a systems approach. Researchers and health decision-makers working in this field require a critical understanding of common aspects and differences in the perspectives of different sectors, enabling them to work effectively within a global ecological perspective on NCDs.

Oil and Complex Systems: the main goal of this program is to understand different behaviors of physical systems at diverse scales. A complementary goal is to contribute to the understanding and modeling of physical processes and phenomena related to oil extraction when enhanced oil recovery mechanisms are used, aiming at developing techniques of computer modeling useful for the oil industry.

Research on Entrepreneur Development and Complex Socio-technical Systems: This Program intends to develop a work team that, in a synergic way, enables the development of the disciplines involved in entrepreneurial development and complex socio-technical systems, focusing on the local and regional entrepreneurial ecosystem.





Information and Communication Technologies (ICT) in Applications of Social Interest: This program proposes a comprehensive approach aimed at promoting research and linkage through the study, development and use of computer systems based on new technologies, which allow to provide solutions to the existing problems in the areas of environment, health, productive environment and education. In addition, it is of special interest to provide such solutions within the territory of influence of the Universidad Nacional Arturo Jauretche (UNAJ).

Educational and Pedagogical Inclusion in the University: this program seeks to address educational issues related to inequity, from a complex and interdisciplinary perspective. It involves different dimensions concerning pedagogical matters, such as university teaching, trajectories of students, specific didactic needs, policies for educational inclusion, and education institutions.

**Environment and Territory Studies**: the program aims to generate and promote academic activities in the area of environment, in order to contribute to the sustainable development of society. It involves different areas of interest, such as environment and sustainability of complex systems, health and environment, water and territory, urban ecology, and climate change.

Observatory of Labor Skills: the observatory seeks to survey information related to existing job skills and demands in the labor market. It has a permanent interaction with the socio-productive context in order to develop diagnosis and formulate proposals for a better coordination between vocational training and the changing requirements of the productive system.

Observatory of Social Violence: the observatory's main goal is to research, assess, and monitor different social violences and their related issues, producing theoretical and technical tools useful for diagnosing





structural and contingent conditions that cause vulnerability and deep social damages. The observatory also seeks to contribute to strengthen social and institutional arrangements for mitigating violence

Human Rights Studies: The general objective of this program is to promote research, knowledge and exercise of human rights in the academic community, localities and society in general, based on a broad concept of human rights that includes the areas where these rights are violated. The research lines include:

1. Human rights, public policies for memory, truth and justice, State terrorism and genocide in Argentina and Latina America; 2. Human rights, citizenship and democracy; 3. Economic, social and cultural rights; 4. Human rights, education and culture.

## SCHOOL OF INITIAL STUDIES: RESEARCH PROGRAMS

**Culture Studies**: the Program's general objective is to contribute, through action-research in the field of culture of our near people (both in terms of space and time) to the achievement of aspirations for a decent life for the community.

**Gender Studies**: this program is a space for reflection about gender issues related to the Argentine society in general and to the population of the area where UNAJ is located in particular.

**Teaching Studies:** The Teaching Studies Program aims to interpret the teaching and learning processes in UNAJ in order to look for indicators that determine the improvement of its quality. Another aim is to elaborate theory about teaching through the study of methods, techniques, instruments and learning activities mediated by the analysis and discussion of the disciplinary contents assumed as cultural products.

Latin American Studies: from an interdisciplinary standpoint, the program aims to think Latin American issues considering historical, social, political, anthropological, pedagogic, economic, and cultural approaches. The emphasis is that these approaches should be formulated from Latin America, as well as by and for Latin Americans, in order to break old or new European and North American colonialist thinking.

UNAJ has signed more than 50 cooperation agreements with several universities from different regions, with the objective of undertake activities and research and exchange programs in areas of mutual benefit.

UNAJ actively promotes exchange and mobility actions and initiatives, with the aim of increasing opportunities for its professors, researchers, staff and students for professional development and training.
